Could Kentucky represent a state coming into one accord with 120 counties as we celebrate the authority of the Word of God and read it out loud from seats of government or college campuses all over our state?

When **120** people met **in one accord**, the Holy Spirit moved suddenly and people began getting saved daily as spiritual awakening began. Our country desperately needs awakening again. May the Lord move mightily on each county as they participate and may Kentucky begin to lead the way in National Spiritual Transformation.

THE CONCEPT OF BIBLE READING MARATHONS

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.”

John 1:1

“God is Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.”

John 4:24

*“If ye continue in My Word, then are ye My disciples indeed;
And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”*

John 8:31-32

*“All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine,
for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.”*

II Timothy 3:16

“Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My Words shall not pass away.”

Matthew 24:35

God provided His Word for our instruction - it is an operator's handbook for our lives. There is **NOTHING** else we can rely on to provide truth; only the Word of divine Scripture can give us truth.

These end times are troubled times. We must expect them to be so, for the Word tells us they will be. The troubles are a consequence of living in a fallen world of sin that is spiritually dark. Jesus is the light of the world; Jesus is the Word. In worshiping Him through reading His Word, we release spiritual power and authority into our world that will bring about freedom (*spiritual and natural*) and success, consistent with God's plan for us, our community, and our nation.

We have scriptural examples of nations reading the Word such as Moses (*Exodus 19:7-8*), King Josiah (*II Kings 23:1-3*), and Ezra (*Nehemiah 8:1-9*), among others. Through proclaiming the Word, that is, reading aloud for all to hear, these leaders changed the spiritual and natural conditions of the hearers and their nations.

We want to again proclaim the Word for the blessing of ourselves and the healing of our state, bringing about spiritual change in the heavens that will manifest in our natural world. The concept is to gather a group of dedicated believers to read the Bible aloud continuously from Genesis 1:1 to Revelation 22:21. Readers take turns, following one another, speaking out the Word of God, thereby releasing the power and authority of His Spirit into the heavens in our times. While the reading/proclaiming progresses, other believers are encouraged to be in prayer, lifting up the needs of the community and state. Our heart's desire is to have concurrent Bible Reading in progress at the same time in all 120 counties of Kentucky.

In Heaven, we will be part of that great multitude *“of all nations, and kindreds, and people and tongues,”* (*Revelation 7:9*) standing before the throne, proclaiming the glories of God. Participation in **KY 120 United Bible Reading Marathon** can be a small foretaste of that heavenly one, and it will advance the coming of the kingdom. May God bless you and enable you to accomplish His will.

BASIC OUTLINE

WHY

Because God has esteemed His Word even above all His Name (*Psalms 138:2*). To publicly honor the Lord and unite the community by openly proclaiming the only inspired Guide to prepare us to fulfill His Will.

WHEN

Starting Sunday, January 1st. 12am through Monday, January 4th, 6pm.

WHERE

Choose either your courthouse, city hall or college campus.

WHO

All Believers! Any Christian can participate in the reading. *“So shall My Word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it” (Isaiah 55:11).*

ITEMS TO CONSIDER

- 👉 **PA System** - Your system should be one that has sufficient volume and quality if you are having your Marathon outside. The entire PA system, including the microphone, must be carefully tested and fine-tuned ahead of time.
- 👉 **Lighting System** - Should be adequate for night reading. Having good lighting is also a safety measure. Include spare light bulbs.
- 👉 **Electrical Outlets** - Make sure there are enough outlets for speakers, lighting, etc. Also check that your location has ample wattage available to plug in all necessary equipment. Be sure all outlets are protected from the elements.
- 👉 **Platform or Stand for Readers** - Also provide an extra stool for platform for small readers, especially if you have children involved. A platform is a good place to display your banner and any other type of decorations you may want.
- 👉 **Podium** - If possible, set up two lecterns (*one for the current reader; the other for the next reader*) to avoid delays. Each lectern should have a good microphone attached to it.
- 👉 **Bible** - Have large or giant print Bibles available for easier reading, but encourage readers to bring their own personal Bibles.
- 👉 **Banner or identifying sign** - A waterproof banner is best. You may choose your own wording. A suggested wording might be: *“Kentucky 120 United, Bible Reading Marathon.”*
- 👉 **Seating** - You will want chairs for those who are participating and for groups waiting to read, as well as sufficient chairs for intercessors and listeners.
- 👉 **Umbrellas, water jugs, cups, etc.** - Have these items all located in one spot, off to the side and out of the way. Oversize umbrellas are a great help in rainy conditions!
- 👉 **Large plastic bags** - Have several on hand that are large enough to cover sound equipment if it should rain. You will also need a few trash bags during and after the Marathon. We represent Christ and need to leave the reading area cleaner than when we began.
- 👉 **Small Emergency Kit** - Keep a first aid kit handy, just in case of minor accidents.
- 👉 **Camera, Video, Etc.** - You may need to obtain a special permit if you plan to use photographers or video cameras. Check out well in advance.
- 👉 **Telephone** - It is wise to have a cellular phone available for security purposes as well as for Co-coordinator and media people.
- 👉 **Refreshments** - Providing refreshments for readers is a nice touch of hospitality. A caterer or restaurant might be willing to contribute this free of charge.
- 👉 Be sure to **publicly acknowledge** those businesses and/or organizations who help supply equipment, refreshments and other items for the Marathon.

WHAT IS A BIBLE READING MARATHON?

A Bible Reading Marathon is a planned program for many people to read through the entire Bible without stopping. Individuals take turns reading Scripture sequentially from Genesis to Revelation. The entire Word of God can easily be read from beginning to end at a normal speaking rate in approximately 90 hours.

God's Word is powerful. In a Bible Reading Marathon we speak the supernatural power of God's Word into our natural world.

The term, "*Marathon*" was coined from the field of sports. The Apostle Paul spoke of "*running the race.*" Athletes run relay races as well as 26 mile marathon races. Bible Reading Marathon readers similarly read sequentially, as in a relay race, and with endurance, as in a marathon. As one person reads, the next reader should be standing by, making ready for their turn before the other one finishes. If the assigned person does not show up, someone else should fill that slot, so that the Word is proclaimed in a continuous, uninterrupted flow.

PRINTED MATERIAL - The following is a list of materials that will be helpful in conducting a Bible Reading Marathon. With the exception of the Bible, these materials are included for reproduction.

- A. *Bible with large print*
- B. *Reader Team Captain's assignments*
- C. *Covenant Agreement for all participants*
- D. *Scripture schedule for readers*
- E. *Letter to Pastor's*
- F. *Follow up Letter*

KEY PEOPLE - These are the essential personnel for a successful Bible Reading Marathon. They must be capable of handling a task and seeing it through to completion.

- A. *Marathon Coordinator/General Overseer for each county.*
- B. *Publicity Coordinator*
- C. *Reader Team Captain - one for each 3 hour watch*
- D. *Readers - 12 readers per watch*
- E. *Other helps on location, as required*
- F. *On-call volunteers to fill whatever need arises*

COVENANT AGREEMENT

Each person involved should read and sign the Covenant Agreement. The Covenant Agreement clearly states that the purpose of gathering for a Bible Reading Marathon is only to read and to pray. It is not time to preach, teach, expound on the Word, promote someone's ministry, do business or even visit with one another. There is a time and place for all things and the sole purpose for this gathering is a time to read. Be sure all participants clearly understand the Covenant Agreement before signing it. Anything that disrupts the flow of the Holy Spirit and the intended purpose of the Bible Reading Marathon gathering should not be allowed. Leaders must be polite but very firm in maintaining a holy atmosphere and in keeping the purpose pure before God Almighty.

MARATHON COORDINATOR/GENERAL OVERSEER

The **Marathon Coordinator** is a person who is able to "*catch the vision and run with it.*" The coordinator is a responsible person who: first, is able to visualize the Bible Reading Marathon in its entirety; second, who can communicate that vision to others; and, third, who can follow these guidelines to conduct a Bible Reading Marathon in their own county. These guidelines are to help the coordinator carry out the vision.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Perhaps one of the most important parts of this process is the selection of team captains. These individuals are the ones who must faithfully commit to organizing and overseeing “*watches*.” The “*watch*,” a three hour period, is the marathon’s basic building block and the time during which reading continues nonstop. Team captains should not be over-committed in other areas. They have the responsibility of insuring the reading of the Word continues, whatever else may be happening around them, even if they must read several times themselves. The team captains should be spiritually mature individuals who are known by those with whom they will be working. They need not be ministers or pastors, but they must be faithful and committed workers who are solid, strong Christians.

Their role is to keep the marathon going, no matter what! They ensure that each reader is ready to read in turn. On the platform each reader should be following along with the Scripture text, so there is continuity of thought and so that the spiritual flow is not interrupted. When we are all in the Lord and in the Spirit, there is a flow of the anointing of the Holy Spirit being released. The team captain must deal with any schedule challenges that arise. These men and women manage the platform during the designated three-hour watch.

Not all people read at the same rate, which will affect the schedule. This is not a problem. Some individuals may read several times if the group is small or if scheduled readers do not come. Children may also read. Always be kind and gentle when making a change and give the person an explanation, remembering that “*a soft answer turns away wrath*.” Keep as close to the schedule as possible. Team captains are responsible for finishing their assigned three-hour watch. Some groups may read faster than others and may finish ahead of schedule; this is no cause for alarm. Just keep reading until the next team comes. But when the new captain arrives, they should start with their own assigned Scripture. This will cause some overlap but will help keep the marathon on schedule. It is alright to read passages more than once, based on the reading speed of the groups. The objective here is to keep reading - **DO NOT STOP**. The Bible Reading Marathon is to be a **NONSTOP** marathon of Scripture reading.

FACILITIES AND ENVIRONMENT

Try to schedule your Bible Reading Marathon in front of your courthouse, Judicial Plaza or City Hall. The site of the marathon should be well lit. Occasionally it may be good to lock outside doors, particularly at night.

PUBLICITY

Good publicity before and during the Marathon is essential. Realize that the main reason you are doing this is to glorify God and speak His life-changing Word to your city, county and state. It will encourage other believers near and far to hear what God is doing. Everyone can help get the word out but have ONE designated Media Coordinator to handle all media contacts. This person should have some experience with the media, writing press release, etc. Also, be sure to get radio and television stations involved. This is a great opportunity for “*live*” footage, if they are able. The Media Coordinator should talk in advance with TV and radio new directors and public service directors to get news coverage of the actual event. Have the mayor or other top civic leader declare an official Marathon. Newspapers can take picture of the official signing of the declaration. This makes an excellent opening article to announce the official Bible Reading Marathon event.
